If you are interested in becoming a Lifeguard (leisure assistant) and you are a strong swimmer we can provide training.

To qualify for training you will need to:

- Complete and return a GLL application form
- Successfully pass a structured swim test
- Successfully pass a formal interview

If successful at swim test and interview you will be offered a place on one of our sponsored NPLQ courses which may lead to casual employment with GLL, the dates for courses are set through out the year and consist of 9 places per course, only.

A copy of the swim test used to test candidates and information regarding the Leisure Assistant role, will be sent to each candidate once their Application Form has been received by GLL and the candidate is invited to attend for a swim test and formal interview.

Once candidates are allocated a place on a sponsored NPLQ course they must commit to 100% attendance, the course will last for 6 days usually (Monday – Saturday). The majority of our courses run during term times, *there are very limited courses running during half term dates.*

GLL require enthusiastic, hard working, customer focussed and business driven people. Sound like you?

We will require proof of identity (passport, driver's licence), a professional reference (*within the last 3 months on company headed paper*) and original copies of any relevant qualifications, valid visa, work permit or worker registration documentation if applicable. All GLL employees are police checked.
